

For over 30 years, Amy Ray has been renowned as one half of the Grammy-award winning folk duo Indigo Girls. She is also a community activist and has had an indie label, Daemon Records since 1989. With her debut solo album, *Stag* (2001), Ray turned in her acoustic for an electric and delivered a critically acclaimed album that showed her love of punk and rock. Since then, she has released five more solo rock albums; *Prom*, *Didn't It Feel Kinder*, *Live from Knoxville*, *Lung of Love*, and *MVP Live*. Her first foray into country music came with her traditional country / Americana release, *Goodnight Tender* in 2014. She followed up with the release, *The Tender Hour* in 2015, a live recording of her country and rock exploits from The Triple Door, in Seattle. Amy is currently working on a new batch of songs to play live and take into the studio in 2017.
